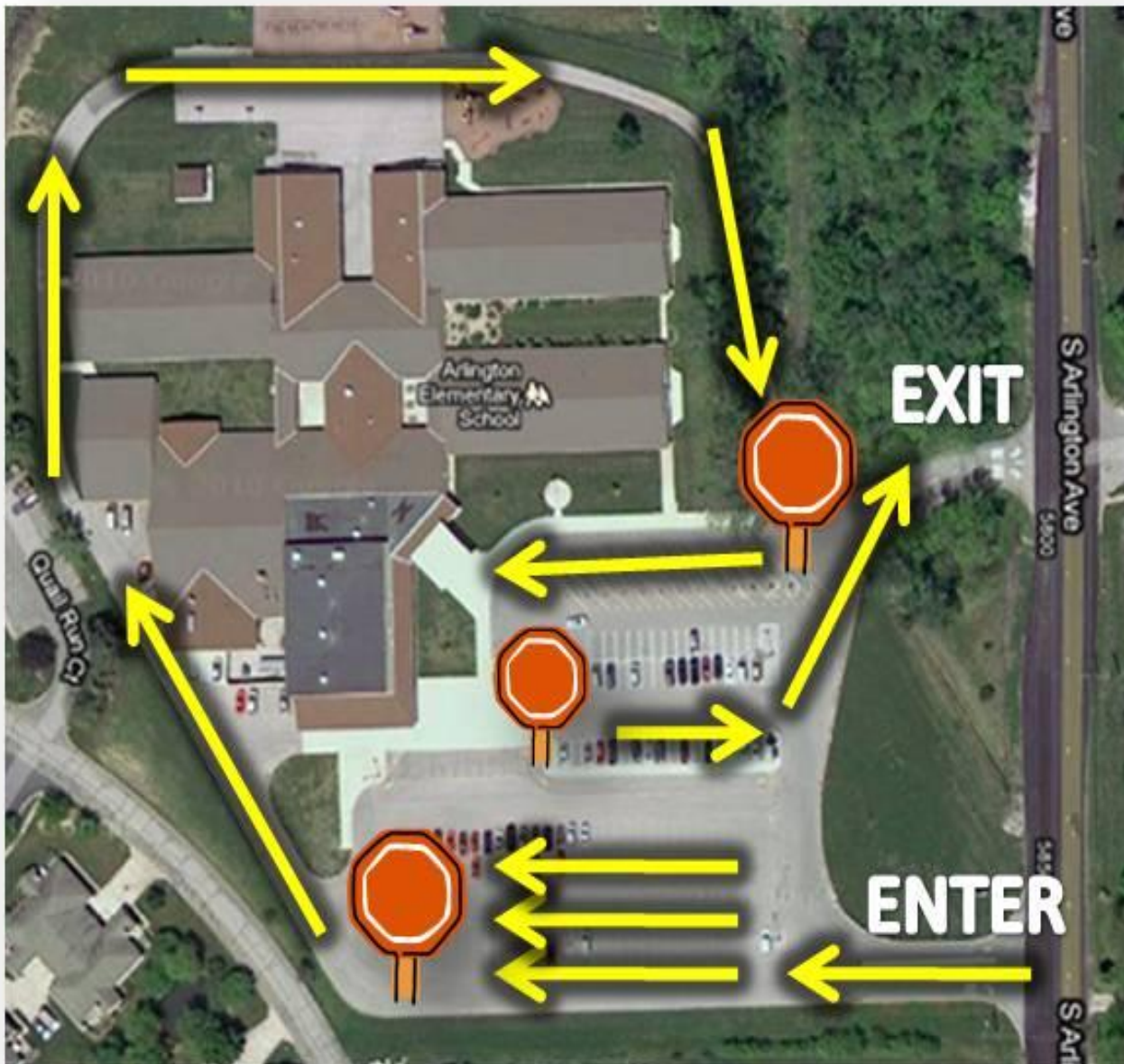

Welcome to the 2011-2012 school year! We have so many things to be excited about this year as we are going above and beyond to “Reach for the STARS!” “STARS” will be our theme throughout the year and serve as our Positive Behavioral Support System which increases student achievement and positive behavior. We will be working together on common procedures, discipline, and goals with fantastic rewards and recognition along the way. Our focus is for each child to shine their brightest and feel like a STAR! More information to come soon!

Here are the things you need to know as we approach the first day of school:

- 1) **Our first day** will be Wednesday, August 10<sup>th</sup>. It will be a full day. But, it is a Wednesday – so it is our normal Wednesday early release (1:40 p.m.). We will serve breakfast starting on the first day of school.
- 2) **School times:**
  - a. Every day: Car, bus unloading, and breakfast begin at 7:05
  - b. Official school time for Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday: 7:25-2:10
  - c. Official school time for Wednesday: 7:25-1:40
- 3) **Transportation:** *Franklin Township NO longer provides bus transportation.* If transportation is needed for your student; please contact CIESC transportation (website: [www.ciesc.k12.in.us](http://www.ciesc.k12.in.us) or call 317-862-2314). You may also register between 12:00 and 3:00 p.m. (Monday – Friday) at their main office located at 8730 Indian Creek Road, Indianapolis, 46259. *You must be registered with CIESC by August 2<sup>nd</sup> to be eligible to ride the bus on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school!!!!*
- 4) **Car Riders morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up:** Please see the map and directions on the following page.
- 5) **Doctors’ appointments and early pick-up:** Every minute your child is in school is important. If possible, please try to schedule appointments for after school hours. If you must pick up a student during school hours, please send a note and he will be called to the office upon your arrival to the office. *Due to the new transportation situation we will be unable to release individual students for appointments after 1:30 p.m.*
- 6) **Ice Cream Social – Kindergarten Orientation:** On Monday, August 8<sup>th</sup> from 5:00-7:00 p.m., the building will be open for you to walk around and find the student’s classroom and the PTO will serve ice cream for everyone to enjoy. Kindergarten Orientation will be this night as well. *Kindergarten parents will have orientation in their student’s classroom from 6:00 – 7:00 p.m.*
- 7) **Class Lists:** 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade class lists are posted on the school’s front doors. Our Kindergarten lists are TBA.
- 8) **PTO:** Arlington has a wonderful PTO! They meet the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of every month @ 6:30 p.m. **The first PTO meeting will be held on August 4<sup>th</sup> @ 6:30 p.m. in the school library.** You may also contact the PTO by emailing them at [arl\\_ptoa@yahoo.com](mailto:arl_ptoa@yahoo.com)

Below is a map of our car rider procedures. **All cars will enter the south lot and all cars will exit the north lot and wrap all the way around the building.** Drop-off will be from 7:05-7:25 and will be single drop-off line curving around the front sidewalk. Pick-up will be from 2:10-2:40 and be multiple lines with students walking to their cars.
